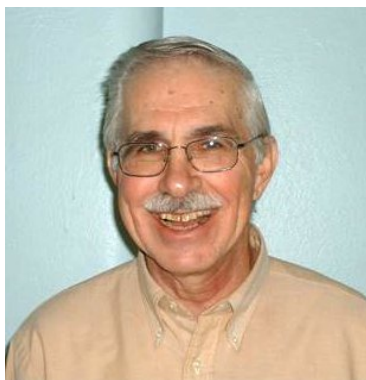

On behalf of Kiwanis International, thank you for submitting your proposal for the next Worldwide Service Project. We received approximately 200 proposals from all over the world. Now a special committee has the challenging task of reviewing the proposals, selecting the finalists and making a recommendation to the Kiwanis International Board of Trustees.

During the selection process, the committee may choose to interview the finalists. Additionally, there will also be an opportunity for our more than 600,000 members worldwide to comment on the next Worldwide Service Project. Announcement of the final selection is scheduled for the Opening Session of the 95th Annual Kiwanis International Convention in Las Vegas, Nevada in June 2010.

As you may be aware, Kiwanis International's first Worldwide Service Project virtually eliminated Iodine Deficiency Disorders worldwide. Working with the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) and the U.S. Fund for UNICEF, the entire Kiwanis Family of organizations raised approximately US\$100 million to fund this monumental effort.
