Let me tell you the story of Malachi House.....

Mission Statement: Malachi House ministers to individuals who need an available caregiver, who have limited or no financial resources and are in need of special home care in the final stages of life.

Opened in 1988 and expanded in 2001, the home contains facilities to accommodate 15 residents in private bedrooms, a kitchen, living room, dining room, chapel, enclosed porches and activity room. The interior design and decor emphasize the warmth and comfort of a home environment.

Malachi House is home for persons who are terminally ill and face death alone or without appropriate caregiver support; for persons who are not eligible for hospitalization or nursing home care; for persons who lack the financial resources to receive other kinds of care.

Malachi House receives no government funding. They are privately funded through the generosity of individuals, foundations and corporations as well as an annual benefit, golf tournaments and other fundraisers.

Volunteers are essential to MalachiHouses' successful operation.
