Anyone with KCL envelopes with Matt Mathiott's address is asked to return them to Rae Lou Wilkinson who has updated labels that can be used.....Matt Rawlings, Co-chair of the Membership Committee announced the committee is continuing an aggressive approach for new members and will be holding another membership day at a June 9th meeting.....Don Fox reported on the clean up and planting of flowers in the KCL Adopt-A-Spot in Lakewood Park and thanked those who helped.....Dick Seib reported on the winners of the first golf outing of the year, and reminded our golfers of the July 15, Ohio District golf outing at Tam O'Shanter Golf Course.....Bo Rog our Fund Raising Chairman has scheduled the set up for our May 31, Pancake Breakfast will be on Saturday morning at The Church of the Ascension and the preparations on Sunday will begin at 6:30 A.M. Volunteers for these days and times are needed and a sign up sheet will be at our weekly meetings.....

.....*From the May 14, Board Meeting*.....

A letter from the Lakewood Foundation was read thanking the KCL for its generous donation of \$500 for the Spring Fling event....The Membership Committee has taken on the task of monitoring the "Get the Red Out" KCL program of integrating new members into the KCL. The committee is also reviewing new membership classifications and will be making recommendations to the board in the near future.....The board approved the calendar of fundraising events for the remainder of the year.....July 19, Chicken & Ribs Dinner, Lakewood Kiwanis Pavilion; September 27, our annual Clam Bake. Details will be made available as plans are completed for the events.....Eight members of the Lakewood High School Key Club attended the Key Club convention (the most ever) in Columbus on April 25th.....The KCL Community Service Committee is beginning to plan for a "Meals That Heal" event for which we would cook 45 meals and supply them to a women's shelter....The KCL has donated funding for the June 6, "Meet the Trucks" event at Lakewood Park. The event features all the city trucks, fire equipment police cruisers mobile equipment, etc that will be on display to see, touch, and even blow the horns! The KCL is a "Silver Sponsor" of the event.....The board approved funding for the East End Family Room, family literacy program called "Learn Through Play".....Also approved was the funding of the YMCA's "Strong Kids Campaign". Funding will be used to support the Lakewood YMCA scholarship program. Scholarship funds ensure that everyone is able to participate regardless of their ability to pay.0000
